## PROVINCIAL PARK NATURE TRAIL

Bear Creek Canyon Trail is dedicated to Dave Brewer, a Park Ranger who designed and constructed this trail in 1981. Unfortunately, years later, Dave lost his life in the line of duty working in Wells Gray Provincial Park.

Welcome to the Bear Creek Nature Trail. The Loop Trail section offers a short 15 minute walk. The Canyon Rim Trail is approximately 2.5 kilometres long with an elevation gain of 90 metres. The average time to complete this trail is about 2 hours. A shorter distance can be hiked by using the Mid Canyon Trail cut-off.

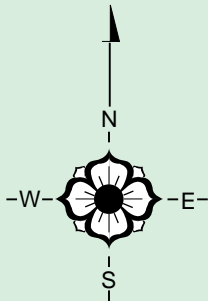
Dangerous cliffs and drop-offs!
