Bear Prevention

This Park is home to both grizzly and black bears.
Please follow these rules to ensure both your own and the bears safety.

Bears that become habituated **WILL be destroyed.**

Do NOT feed bears

Use food caches or hang your food in a tree or on a high bar
Completely put out your fires!

PACK IT IN - PACK IT OUT

Trail Etiquette

The trails within Big Creek Park are used by hikers, horses and bicycles.
Please be courteous to all other users, so that everyone can have a safe and enjoyable
experience.

Keep dogs on a leash at all times

Bikers yield to hikers and horses

Hikers yield to horses

Stay on trails

Wait on the downhill side of trails when yielding

Ride, **don't slide**

Bikes; please use bells

Be **cautious** at blind corners – bikers; remember to warn other users on these corners!
