

Snowmobiling in Callaghan Lake Provincial Park

Snowmobiling is permitted through the park on an unmarked, non-maintained, single corridor route only. The corridor includes the main park road, the crossing of Callaghan Lake and the traditional, steep forested route, "128A St.", from the north end of the lake to the alpine ridge (see map for details).

This is a wilderness park. Please respect the natural environment.

View wintering wildlife such as mountain goat, wolverine and wolf from a distance.

Pack out what you pack in.

Please do not store fuel in the park.

Be aware of other snowmobile traffic, non-motorized park visitors, avalanche hazards and lake crossing conditions.

Snowmobiling on open water is prohibited.

Ride safely and enjoy the park.
