Hiking Trails

Yew Lake Trail: Trail is clear and in good condition. Dogs are not permitted on the Yew Lake Trail. Barrier-free access starts adjacent to the Cypress Creek Lodge at the downhill area. Please note that the odd pothole may be encountered on the road towards the trail proper.

Baden Powell Trail: Trail is clear and in good condition.

Black Mtn. Plateau: A few muddy sections.

Hollyburn Lower Trails: Trails are clear and in good condition.

Hollyburn Mountain Trail: Trail is clear and in good condition.

Blue Gentian/West Lake Trails: Trails are clear and in good condition.

Howe Sound Crest Trail – South : Watch for downed trees beyond St Mark's.

Howe Sound Crest Trail – North (Deeks Lake): Parking at the northern end is located just off the new Porteau Road exit, adjacent to the overpass. Please hike up the gravel road to find the signposts for the trail. The emergency shelters at Magnesia Meadows and Brunswick Lake were replaced last year. Please note that they are for emergency use only.

Daylight hours are decreasing rapidly.

Daylight Saving Time ends November 1st - sunset occurs one hour earlier.
