Perimeter Trail: Trail is under snow.

Goldie/Flower Lake: Trail is under snow.

Mystery Lake: Trail is under snow.

Dog Mt./First Lake: Trail is under snow.

Mt. Seymour Main Trail: Trail is under snow.

Elsay Lake Trail: Travel not recommended until snow has disappeared.
