







Welcome to the Park

A wide, sandy beach and 200 campsites, including 25 walk-in, nestled in old-growth forests make Rathrevor Beach Provincial Park one of the most popular on Vancouver Island. At low tide the water recedes nearly a kilometre, creating ideal conditions to explore the shoreline, play in the water or observe marine wildlife. Birdwatching is especially popular in the spring, when the herring spawn and seabirds gather to feast, and during the Brant Geese migration in March and April.

Things to Do

-  The rising tide over sun-heated sand makes for lovely swimming. There are no lifeguards on duty.
-  There are two adventure playgrounds - one in the campground and another in the day-use area.
-  There are 5.5 km of easy walking trails, most wheelchair accessible, through mature forest and along the beach.
-  Fishing is permitted with the appropriate licence.
-  The Rathrevor Nature House offers interpretive programming in the summer.
-  The beach is accessible by canoe and kayak; paddlers are advised to check tide charts as tide can be very low.

Enjoy Your Stay

Park regulations protect the natural state of the park and ensure a quality experience for all visitors.

- Fires are permitted in designated fire rings only.
- Pets must be on a leash at all times. Please be responsible for their behaviour and waste.
- Reservations are strongly recommended from the last week of June to Labour Day.

Visitor Services

-  There are three shower buildings in the campground.
-  Campsites, showers, flush toilets, beach access and parking in the day-use area are wheelchair accessible.
-  Visitors can use sani-station for a fee.
-  Pit toilets are located throughout the park. Flush toilets are at the day-use area and the campgrounds.
-  There are group sites available to reserve.
-  The large day-use area near the beach has picnic tables, 2 reservable picnic shelters and a playground.

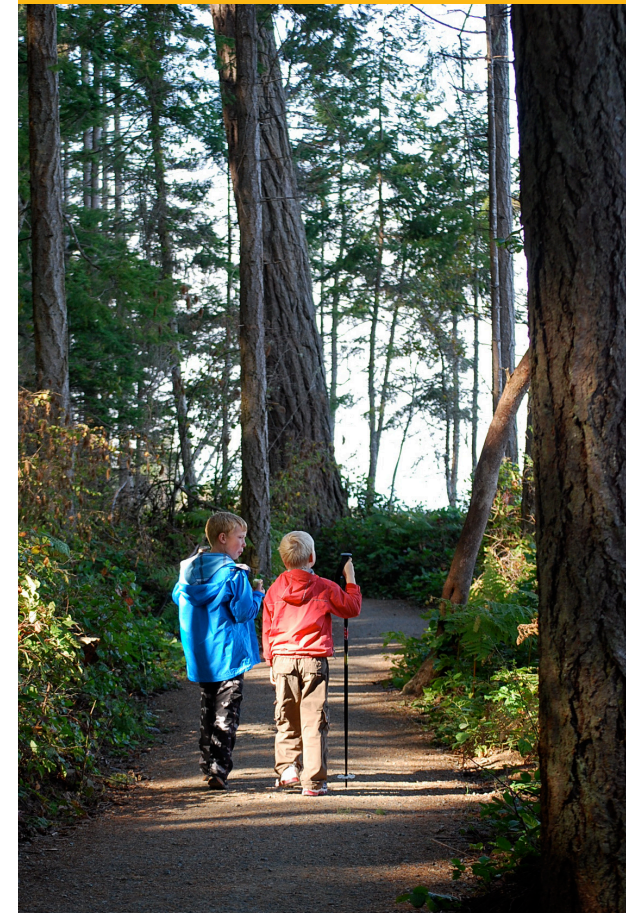

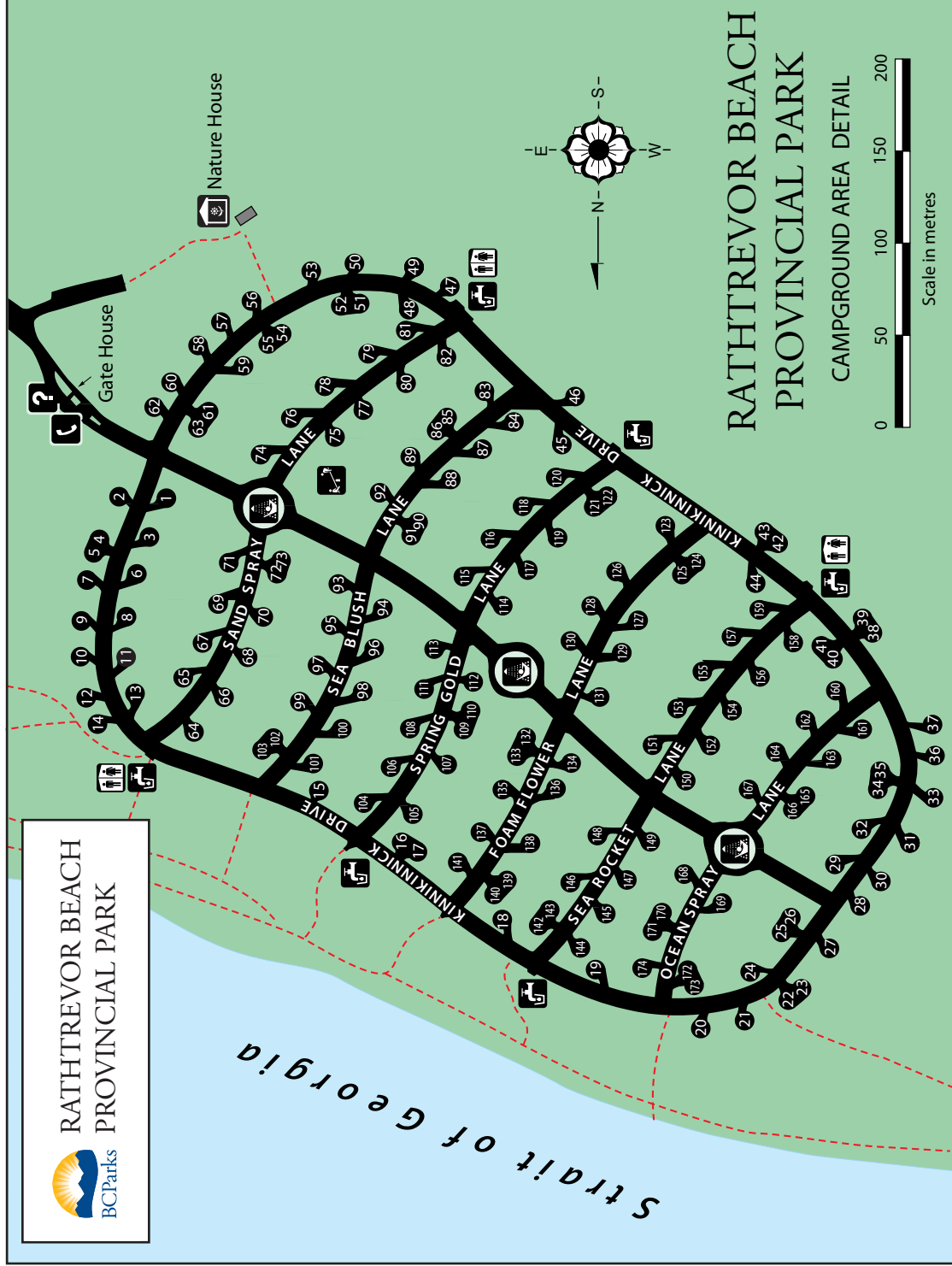
