



PREPARATION FOR FILMING ACTIVITY NOTICE

Monday, August 20, 2018

Dear Strathcona Park visitors of Ralph River Campground & Buttle Lake area;

Subject to BC Parks approvals, Eye On the Ball Productions Inc will be implementing some site preparation work at Ralph River Campground for a future filming project this Fall. This work will start as soon as possible after August 22 / 2018 once final approvals have been received and will include the development of a temporary film set located on the lake front area adjacent to Ralph River.

In order for the production to access the lake shore area safely, we have requested permission to develop a temporary access path off the existing trail located next to visitor parking and between Campsites R18 & R19. As Ralph River Campground is currently being upgraded, the path is also being considered for a future wheelchair accessible trail and emergency vehicle route to the lakeshore area.

Subject to BC Parks approvals, it is our hope to start set development on Monday August 27 to be ready for film production commencing on October 5, 2018. After filming is complete in November, we will clean and restore the site to its former state and/or enhance the site to the satisfaction of BC Parks.

Our goal is to complete all work with as little impact on the visitors to the Park as possible. Although we will try to minimize noise and any inconvenience we understand there may be some things which are unavoidable and we ask for your understanding and cooperation. We plan to do any "noisy work" between the hours of 9AM - 5PM with breaks throughout the day.

During our preparation stage, the area will be slightly busier than usual. In order to maintain public safety, we may ask you to use alternative route(s) around working areas during elected times. Identifiable "Production Assistants" will be on site and available to assist you at any time with guidance and answering of any questions and/or concerns you may have.
