Park Act

Order of the Regional Director

TO: Public Notice

DATE: July 14, 2017

WHEREAS:

A. Carp Lake Park ("the Park") which is located approximately 174 km northwest of Prince George and 78 km southwest of Mackenzie.

B. The Park is a Class A park established under the *Park Act* in 1973;

C. Wildfire G10864, G10879 and G10883 are burning in Carp Lake Park and threatening a number of structures and public safety in the area.

D. Wildfire Management Branch operating in the area also needs to be able to operate in a safe manner.

E. Section 17 of the Park Act states:

A director or any park officer acting on the director's behalf may do one or more of the following:


(c) order any person in any park, conservancy or recreation area to

cease or refrain from an action, an omission or conduct that the director or park officer, in his or her discretion, considers dangerous to life or property or detrimental to the public interest;

ACCORDINGLY, the Regional Director orders:

1. Remove the closure of Carp Lake Provincial Park to all recreational uses, and;
2. Cease the evacuation of any users within the park, and
