

**Approved Park Facility Operator Uniform
and Uniform Guidelines
2003**

1. You must

a) Provide uniforms consisting of the following:

short sleeve shirt, light grey
long sleeve shirt, light grey
work pants, navy blue
coverall, medium grey
summer jacket, medium grey
spring/fall jacket, medium grey
hat (baseball style), medium grey*
tie (clip on), medium grey*; and

The tie and hat are optional. If a hat or tie is worn they **must be that hat and/or tie described above.*

- b) Ensure all staff and Subcontractors wear an approved uniform while on duty; and
- c) Comply with the colour, design, size, and wording of any and all insignia approved by BC Parks; and
- d) Not sew any other identification insignia on a uniform other than those with the name “Park Facility Operator”; and
- e) Identify every shirt, jacket, and coverall with the approved “Park Facility Operator” insignia; and
- f) Not display the business name of the Park Facility Operator on any part of the uniform except on an identification card; and
- g) Purchase all uniform components designated for Park Facility Operator use through:

or from a supplier approved by us in writing.

2. At all times,

- a) Uniforms will be clean and tidy, free of offensive odours and stains; and

- b) The specified uniform or parts thereof will not be worn in any liquor store or any premises primarily licensed for the consumption of alcohol, and
- c) Park Facility Operator identification insignia must be visible with the exception of the wearing of rain gear over the uniform.
