Provincial Regulation Simplification and Harmonization - Cariboo Region

BC resident license sales and data from the National Sportfishing Survey indicate angling participation has decreased by more than 20% since the mid 1990s. As part of a larger initiative to recruit and maintain recreational anglers in British Columbia, the Ministry of Environment (MOE) is currently working towards simplifying and harmonizing small lakes regulations throughout the Province. The new regulations format will be used starting in spring of 2009.

In order to provide clear and consistent regulations for anglers across the Province, MOE has grouped fishing regulations into 4 categories called Suites (Table 1). Each of these suites provides fisheries management options similar to what is already in place on many lakes in the Cariboo Region. In addition to the suites, many lakes will follow the general Regional Regulations and will not be itemized in the tables. Only under unique circumstances where its determined management objectives cannot be met using one of the four regulatory suites will lakes show up in the regulations synopsis with waterbody specific regulations.

Most Regulatory suites were chosen for lakes based on the ability of the particular set of regulations to meet the management objective for the lake. There are a number of objectives lakes are managed for in the Cariboo Region. The primary objective is to ensure the conservation of wild stocks and their habitats. The next objective is to optimize recreational opportunities based on the fishery resource. The most logical way to optimize recreational opportunity while also conserving wild stocks is to maximize benefits from the provincial stocking program. While the priority for wild stocks is conservation, stocked lakes are managed to maximize recreational opportunity. Its important opportunities are provided for all anglers of all skill levels. The use of different regulations is a key tool in providing a diversity of angling opportunities.

Following are Cariboo Region lakes that have had regulations modified to fit into one of the four suites. Regulations on and streams and large lakes, not listed in the following table, will not undergo changes related to the Regulation Harmonization process. In addition, regulations on some lakes did not have to be modified to fit into a suite and therefore have not been included in the following tables.

Public Participation in the Process
