



In reply to your request for:

- a licence to transport hazardous waste within the Province of British Columbia;
- the renewal of an existing Hazardous Waste Transport Licence; or
- the revision of an existing Hazardous Waste Transport Licence

The following must be provided to the ministry:

1. A completed application form;
2. Registration and insurance documents indicating that each vehicle and trailer is owned or leased by the applicant, and is covered by a minimum of \$5,000,000 third party legal liability insurance. In the case of large companies, a dated fleet list must be submitted, along with verification of \$5,000,000 third party legal liability insurance;
3. A financial security (\$10,000 Cdn) in the form of a safekeeping agreement, a letter of credit or guarantee, a surety bond, a bank draft, money order or cash. Note that all carriers, with the exception of those who transport *used batteries only*, must provide the security in their submission;
4. A **non-refundable** licence fee (payable to the Minister of Finance) of \$500.00 for a new licence or \$200.00 for the renewal of an existing licence. Note that all carriers, with the exception of those who transport *used batteries only*, must provide the licence fee in their submission;
5. A passing score on the appropriate Hazardous Waste Transport Licence test;
6. A list of known consignors;
7. Consignee waste acceptance confirmation letter(s) including an authorization number (permit or other) and the hazardous waste(s) that each consignee is authorized to accept; and,
8. A contingency plan for spills of the waste(s) transported under the licence.

Enclosed are instructions, samples and recommended formats concerning the above information. This information should not be interpreted as a commitment on the part of the ministry to issue a transport licence.
