Thank you for submitting on October 13<sup>th</sup>, 2006, Electronics Product Stewardship Canada's Product Stewardship Plan as required by section 4 of the Recycling Regulation and the supplementary letter of November 10<sup>th</sup>, 2006.

I have completed my review of the plan and the supplementary information and am satisfied that the plan meets the requirements of the Recycling Regulation and hereby approve the plan. Please be advised that this approval does not extend to any materials or content contained in the plan that are extraneous to the requirements of section 5 of the Recycling Regulation.

My approval comes with my understanding that your plan contemplates a new program and that you must first establish a base from which to continuously improve. My expectation is that as you move from the planning stage to implementation, and reach key milestones (e.g. knowing the physical location of collection facilities, development of a policy for re-use organizations, establishment of a public awareness target, etc.), you will report these to the ministry and the public in a timely manner. I also expect that you will report on the progress towards these key milestones in your Annual Report as required under section 8 of the Recycling Regulation.

As you know, we are working with all stewards on the issue of dispute resolution and will be including you in discussions on this topic in the near future.

I look forward to working with you to ensure the success of this program.
