In accordance with Section 5 of the Public Notification Regulation, within 15 days after the date of application, a readable copy of the application must be posted in a conspicuous place at all main road entrances to the property (or other suitable location(s)) for a period of not less than 30 days.

If the application is for the treatment or disposal of Special Waste, for a Reviewable Project, or at the discretion of the manager, the applicant may be required to post the application on a billboard as specified in Schedule B of the Public Notification Regulation.

PUBLICATION AND NOTICE REQUIREMENTS

Publishing of this permit application will be required in accordance with Section 6 of the Public Notification Regulation. The applicant will be notified by ministry staff with publishing instructions. The applicant is responsible for all expenses incurred in publishing the application.

If the applicant does not own the property associated with the discharge, emission or storage, the applicant must mail or deliver a copy of the application to the owner of the property, and provide proof to the manager, within 30 days after the date of the application that the property owner has been advised of the application.
