NOTICE – INDICATORS OF THE AMOUNT, DISTRIBUTION AND ATTRIBUTES OF WILDLIFE HABITAT REQUIRED FOR THE SURVIVAL OF GRIZZLY BEAR IN THE SQUAMISH NATURAL RESOURCE DISTRICT Amendment

This Notice is given under the authority of section 7(3) of the *Forest Planning and Practices Regulation* (B.C. Reg. 14/04) and 9(3) of the *Woodlot Licence Planning and Practices Regulation* (B.C. Reg. 21/04).

This Notice applies to the Squamish Natural Resource District (formerly Squamish Forest District) and replaces the amount, distribution and attributes provided for Grizzly Bear in the Notice for the Squamish Natural Resource District dated December 30, 2004. The December 30, 2004 Notice remains in effect for Marbled Murrelet and Spotted Owl.

This Notice removes the obligation of a forest tenure holder to specify a result or strategy in relation to the objective set out in section 7(2) of the *Forest Planning and Practices Regulation* and 9(3) of the *Woodlot Licence Planning and Practices Regulation* (B.C. Reg. 21/04), defined in the December 30, 2004 Notice for Grizzly Bear in the Squamish Natural Resource District.
