Kootenay Lake Large Rainbow Trout Tagging Program

In order to better understand the biology of large rainbow trout (Gerrards), numbered, color-coded plastic ‘spaghetti’ and ‘loop’ tags have been applied to rainbow trout in Kootenay Lake.

If you catch a tagged rainbow trout, whether you are releasing or harvesting it, please clip off the tag(s) with scissors, side cutters or knife, and record the date and location of capture. Reward tags, which are orange and include the text “\$100 REWARD” are worth \$100 per fish. ALL tag information is central to the success of this study.

Please report the date and location of capture, whether you kept or released the trout, and tag number(s), and return the tag(s) either in person or by mail to:
