Proposed Fishing Regulation Change For Green Timbers Lake

The Ministry of Environment is proposing to change the trout/char daily catch quota for Green Timbers Lake from 4 to 2 fish. This change would be effective April 1, 2010.

Reasons for the change:

- ◆ The ministry and its partners, the Freshwater Fisheries Society of BC and the City of Surrey, recognize the value of Green Timbers Lake as a family fishing lake.
- ◆ Green Timbers is a very small urban lake that attracts many anglers. Our goal is to provide more anglers with the opportunity to catch and keep fish.
- ◆ A 2 trout/char quota is a reasonable balance between the ministry's regional daily catch quota of 4 and the City of Surrey's recommended quota of 1 for Green Timbers Lake.

It is suggested that anglers adopt the 2 trout/char daily catch quota while angling Green Timbers Lake during the time leading up to April 1, 2010.
