**Reporting of Road Kill Wildlife
Picked Up For Trap Bait**

Road Kill Wildlife Pick Up/Possession

1. Only mule deer, white-tailed deer, elk, moose, black bear or wildlife described in Schedules B and C of the Designation and Exemption Regulation, B.C. Reg. 168/90, may be picked up for use on a trapline, and only if
 - (a) The person picking up the dead wildlife has in his or her possession a valid British Columbia trapping licence, or is exempt from holding a trapping licence,
 - (b) the wildlife has died as a result of a collision with a motor vehicle or locomotive, other than a motor vehicle driven by the trapping licence holder, or the person exempted from holding a trapping licence,
 - (c) the meat of the wildlife is unfit for human consumption,
 - (d) the carcass of the wildlife is used only as bait for traps set under authority of the holder's trapping licence or exemption from having to hold a trapping licence,
 - (e) at the time of possession and transport, the holder of a trapping licence or the person who is exempted from holding a trapping licence, has on their person a current trapping licence or proof that they are exempt from holding a trapping licence.
 2. Trappers must report to the ministry within 30 days after the date of pick up of any specified road kill by completing Sections A through C of this reporting form and by returning this form by mail to the address identified on the front of the form.
 3. Trappers must retain a copy of the completed form for at least two years after the date of pick up.
 4. This form does not permit the sale or export of any picked up wildlife or wildlife parts.
