

After the licensing year ends a questionnaire will be delivered to sub-set of anglers who have purchased a White Sturgeon Conservation Licence.

Depending on survey requirements, anglers who hired the services of a Licensed Angling Guide may be told that there catch will have been recorded by the guide and to disregard the questionnaire.

In order to relate catch and effort distribution data between the questionnaire and the angling guide report submissions on the SharePoint Site and to better understand the distribution of angling pressure, angling guides are required to record their sturgeon guiding activities within the same sections presented here and on the accompanying enlarged maps on pages 2 and 3. Please note that changes to reporting requirements may occur annually. Reporting instructions will be distributed in the angling guide letter that accompanies the annual guide licence

In the report comments field, enter river section identification (e.g., "Harrison River" or "Fraser River Section 7") as described herein.

*A new daily form or new Excel spreadsheet row will be required for each Section fished each day.
