Dear Angling Guide:

I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your interest in Freshwater Angling Guiding within Ministry of Environment. I am forwarding this letter to you so that you are aware of the changes to the policies and procedures which will take affect for the 2008/2009 Angling Guide Licence year.

Please be advised that the Permit Authorization Service Bureau (PASB) will be conducting a Province wide audit regarding public liability insurance and, as a result, we are requiring a copy of your public liability insurance policy for your 2007/08 Angling Guide Licence.

Your insurance policy is generally issued in the name as it appears on your Angling Guide Licence, however, if you could only obtain insurance in your business name, please have your insurance agent/broker write a letter to our office indicating that you and all assistant angling guides associated with your licence are covered in the insurance policy.

The following changes for processing angling guide and assistant angling guide licences will be in effect for the 2008/2009 season onward:

1. When submitting your 2008/09 application for an Angling Guide Licence and in keeping with government standards, you will be required to submit insurance on our *BC Certificate of Insurance* form. This form must be signed by your insurance agent/broker. **Please note we will not process your 2008/09 Angling Guide Licence Application if we have not received your BC Certificate of Insurance form for 2008/09 in addition to your 2007/08 insurance policy.**

All forms are available at our website: <http://www.env.gov.bc.ca/pasb/>. If you are unable to access the internet, you can also receive these forms at your local Service BC office, FrontCounter BC office, or by contacting our office. Please ensure you use the most current application forms from our website.

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2. The Assistant Angling Guide Applications have been revised and the signature of the Angling Guide **must** now be on the application, as the assistant is the employing guide's responsibility. **All assistant angling guides must be covered by the employing guides insurance.**

Reports are to be submitted to our office for the April 1, 2007 – March 31, 2008 season by March 31, 2008. If you are guiding in the month of March then your report can be submitted by April 30, 2008. All waters fished (classified and unclassified) must be reported on by each guide, as well, it is the guide's responsibility to report on these waters including those waters fished by his/her assistant guide(s).

All required information **must** be completed **in full** in order to process your application. Incomplete applications result in delays in processing your Angling Guide Licence. Please note that angling guide applications can take up to 3 weeks to process during our busy season (March through May). When applying outside of those time frames the turnaround time is faster. Please allow for this when sending in your applications next year.

Please note if you have not paid 100% of your classified angler days, they are due by September 30, 2007.
