ORDER – CATEGORY OF SPECIES AT RISK

This order is given under the authority of section 13 (1) of the Government Actions Regulation (B.C. Reg. 582/04).

The Minister of Environment, being satisfied that the list of species identified in Schedule 1 may be affected by forest or range management on Crown Land and require protection in addition to that provided by other mechanisms, orders that the species names listed in the first column of Schedule 1 (2011 category of species at risk replacement names) replace the species names identified in the second column of Schedule 1 (previously established category of species at risk names) for species previously established as species at risk on May 3, 2004, May 30, 2005 and June 5, 2006;
