


ORDER – AMENDMENT TO UNGULATE WINTER RANGE U-1-001, UNIT 59

This order is given under the authority of sections 9(2) and 12(1) of the *Government Actions Regulation* (B.C. Reg. 582/2004).

1. The Deputy Minister of Forests, Lands and Natural Resource Operations orders that:
 - a) the boundary of unit 59 in Ungulate Winter Range (UWR) U-1-001 is amended as shown on the attached map “Amendment to UWR U-1-001, Polygon Unit No. 59”, and contained in the UWR spatial layer stored in the Geographic Warehouse (WHSE_WILDLIFE_MANAGEMENT.WCP_UNGULATE_WINTER_RANGE_SP). The centre point of the line on the map denoting the UWR is what establishes the boundary;
 - b) this boundary replaces the boundary approved for unit 59, U-1-001 on October 18, 2004, for black-tailed deer (*Odocoileus hemionus columbianus*) and Roosevelt elk (*Cervus elaphus roosevelti*);
 - c) where there is any discrepancy between the UWR boundary as shown in the attached map and the UWR spatial layer stored in the Geographic Warehouse (WHSE_WILDLIFE_MANAGEMENT.WCP_UNGULATE_WINTER_RANGE_SP), the boundary as detailed in the UWR spatial file will take precedent; and
 - d) the objectives established for U-1-001 on September 13, 2001 titled “Objectives for the Management of TFL 37 Ungulate Winter Ranges” and the general wildlife measures established for ungulate winter range U-1-001 on October 18, 2004 apply to the amended boundary of unit 59, U-1-001.
