

ORDER - Wildlife Habitat Area # 1-115 to 1-120, 1-122, 1-124 to 1-126, 1-128, 1-129

The following order applies to the areas shown in the maps set out in the attached Schedules A and takes effect on the 13 day of Weerland, 2004.

This order is given under the authority of sections 9(2) and 10(1) of the *Government Actions Regulation* (B.C. Reg. 17/04).

The Deputy Minister of Water, Land and Air Protection orders that:

- 1. the wildlife habitat areas shown in the maps set out in the attached Schedules A (#1-115 to 1-120, 1-122, 1-124 to 1-126, 1-128 and 1-129) are established;
- 2. the wildlife habitat areas in the attached Schedules A are established for Marbled Murrelet (*Brachyramphus marmoratus*); and
- 3. the general wildlife measures outlined in Schedule 1 are established for the wildlife habitat areas in the attached Schedules A:

Schedule 1 – General Wildlife Measures

- 1. Access Do not construct or widen roads unless the designated decision maker is satisfied there is no other practicable option and an exemption is approved.
- 2. Harvesting and Silviculture Do not harvest timber except for salvage or traditional aboriginal purposes when the designated decision maker approves an exemption.
- 3. Recreation Do not develop recreational structures, trails, or facilities.
- 4. *Pesticides* Do not use pesticides unless an exemption is approved by the delegated decision maker.

Note: The Deputy Minister of Water, Land and Air Protection wishes to acknowledge that the above WHAs are contained within an area undergoing landscape unit planning. WLAP is prepared to revisit these WHA boundaries should the draft OGMA boundaries be adjusted upon the completion of landscape unit planning.
