




ORDER

WILDLIFE HABITAT AREAS MINOR BOUNDARY AMENDMENT FOR 1-032 AND 1-104

This order is given under the authority of Sections 9(2) and 10(1) of the *Government Actions Regulation* (B.C. Reg. 582/2004).

1. The Director of Resource Management, West Coast Region, Ministry of Forests, Lands and Natural Resource Operations orders that:
 - a. The boundaries of wildlife habitat areas (WHAs) 1-032 and 1-104 are amended as shown on the attached maps "Amendment to Wildlife Habitat Areas 1-032 and 1-104, and are contained in the WHA spatial layer stored in the GeoBC Geographic Warehouse (WHSE_WILDLIFE_MANAGEMENT.WCP_WILDLIFE_HABITAT_AREA_POLY). The centre point of the line on the map denoting the WHA is what establishes the boundary;
 - b. These boundaries replace the boundaries approved for WHAs 1-032 on and 1-104 on December 15, 2005 for Marbled Murrelets (*Brachyramphus marmoratus*);
 - c. Where there is any discrepancy between the WHA boundaries as shown in the attached map and the WHA spatial layer stored in the GeoBC Geographic Warehouse, the boundaries as detailed in the WHA spatial file will take precedent; and,
 - d. The general wildlife measures approved for WHAs 1-032 and 1-104 on December 15, 2005 continue to apply.
