**Re: Implementation Plan for the Management
of Boreal Caribou in British Columbia**


Background:

In 2011, a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) was entered into among the parties to establish a framework for collaboration and industry support in relation to the implementation of the Government of British Columbia's Boreal Caribou Implementation Plan, which is currently in the process of being updated. The term of the MOU originally expired on August 8, 2016, but was extended by agreement to November 8, 2016. The parties wish to extend the MOU a second time so that active projects can proceed to conclusion without disruption, while the parties pursue the development of a separate agreement that will guide collaboration and industry support in the management of caribou in Northeast British Columbia.

The parties agree to extend the MOU to July 31, 2018.


