ORDER OF THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL

Order in Council No. 606

On the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that, to make provision for a water supply for the use of the Crown for any purpose, the following unrecorded waters of the following streams in the Nanaimo and Victoria Water Districts are reserved, for a period of 5 years from the date this order is made, from being taken or used or acquired under the *Water Act*:

- (a) 2 644 000 cubic metres per year of the unrecorded waters of Shawnigan Creek;
- (b) 3 620 000 cubic metres per year of the unrecorded waters of Englishman River;
- (c) 1 582 000 cubic metres per year of the unrecorded waters of French Creek;
- (d) 691 000 cubic metres per year of the unrecorded waters of Muir Creek;
- (e) 466 000 cubic metres per year of the unrecorded waters of Spectacle Creek;
- (f) 434 000 cubic metres per year of the unrecorded waters of Johns Creek;
- (g) 599 000 cubic metres per year of the unrecorded waters of Bonell Creek;
- (h) 1 007 000 cubic metres per year of the unrecorded waters of Nanoose Creek;
- (i) 230 000 cubic metres per year of the unrecorded waters of Quarantine Lake.
