TLA'AMIN NATION WATER RESERVATION ORDER

Definition

- 1 In this order:
 - “**Tla’amin Citizen**”, “**Tla’amin Corporation**” and “**Tla’amin Public Institution**” have the same meaning as in the Tla’amin Final Agreement;
 - “**Tla’amin Final Agreement**” has the same meaning as in the *Tla’amin Final Agreement Act*.

Water reservation

- 2 Unrecorded water in the amount of 11 225 cubic decametres per year is reserved from being diverted or used under the *Water Sustainability Act* from the streams listed in Schedule 1 of Chapter 7 of the Tla’amin Final Agreement and their tributaries, which water reservation is in favour of the Tla’amin Nation for any purpose other than a power purpose or a storage purpose related to a power purpose.

Acquisition of water reserved

- 3 Despite the reservation under section 2, the water reserved may be acquired under licences in accordance with paragraphs 7 to 13 of Chapter 7 of the Tla’amin Final Agreement by the Tla’amin Nation or, with the consent of the Tla’amin Nation, by a Tla’amin Public Institution, Tla’amin Corporation or Tla’amin Citizen.
