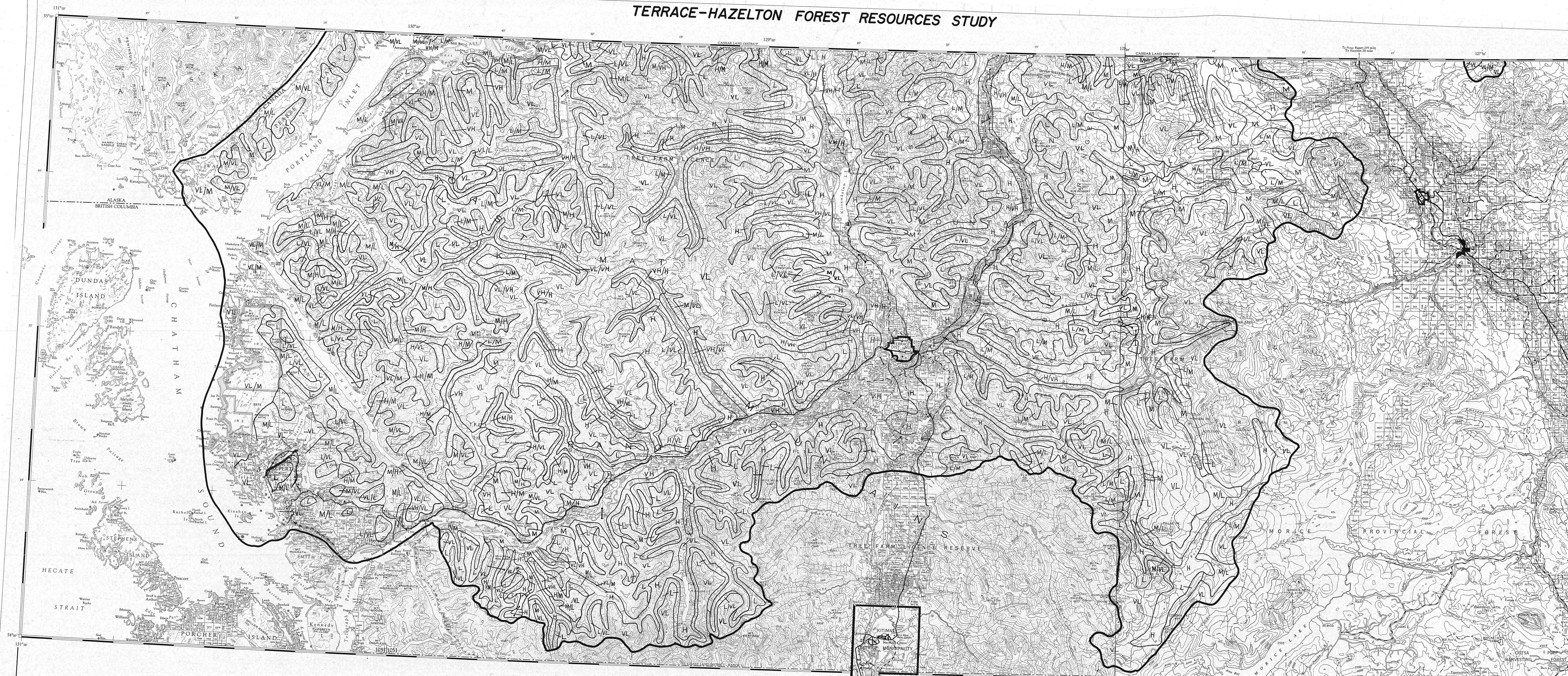


TERRACE-HAZELTON FOREST RESOURCES STUDY



LAND CAPABILITY FOR FORESTRY

LEGEND

VH	Very High	MAI greater than 110 ft. ³ /ac./yr.
H	High	MAI 70 - 110 ft. ³ /ac./yr.
M	Moderate	MAI 50 - 70 ft. ³ /ac./yr.
L	Low	MAI 30 - 50 ft. ³ /ac./yr.
VL	Very Low	MAI less than 30 ft. ³ /ac./yr.

NOTE:-

One or two forest capability symbols were used to describe a unit.
The following is an example of a simple and a complex unit.

VH = 80 - 100% of area within unit has a very high capability for forestry.
VH/M = 50 - 80% of area has a very high capability, and 20 - 50% has moderate capability for forestry.

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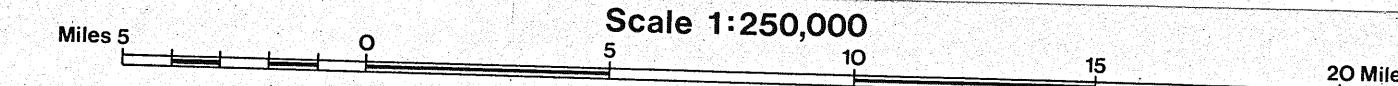
