CAPABILITY RATINGS

Mineral Soils

- Class 3 - Soils in this class have moderately severe limitations that restrict the range of crops or require special conservation practices.
- Class 4 - Soils in this class have severe limitations that restrict the range of crops or require special conservation practices or both.
- Class 5 - Soils in this class have very severe limitations that restrict their capability to produce perennial forage crops, and improvement practices and feasible.

Organic Soils

- Class 02 - Organic soils in this class have moderate limitations that restrict the range of crops.
- Class 03 - Organic soils in this class have moderately severe limitations that restrict the range of crops or require special management practices.
- Class 04 - Organic soils in this class have severe limitations that restrict the range of crops or require special management practices or both.
- Class 05 - Organics soils in this class have very severe limitations that restrict their capability for the production of perennial forage and other specially adapted crops.

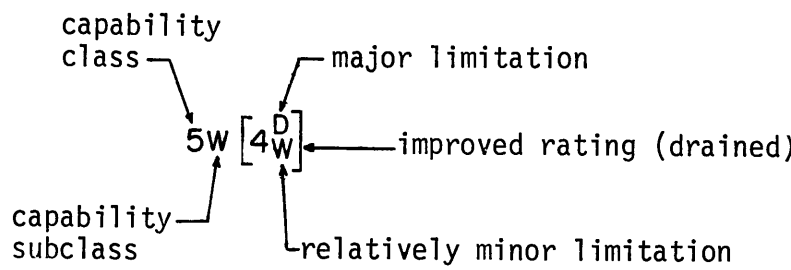
CAPABILITY SUBCLASSES

(Mineral and Organic Soils)

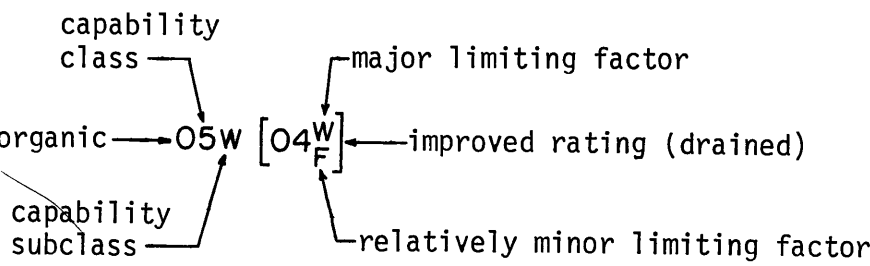
- D - Undesireable soil structure and/or low permeability

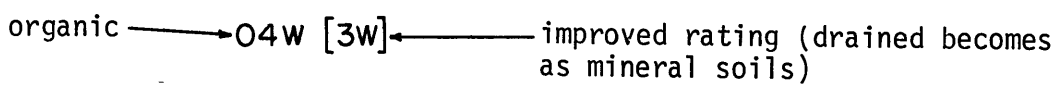
Mineral Soils
