Symbol	Definition
A	- streams with poorly confined channels (ravine depth 3M)
B	- streams with moderately confined channels (ravine depth 3-6 M)
C	- streams with well confined channels (ravine depth 6M)
M	- surface ponding
S	- seepage zones

B. Size of Stream

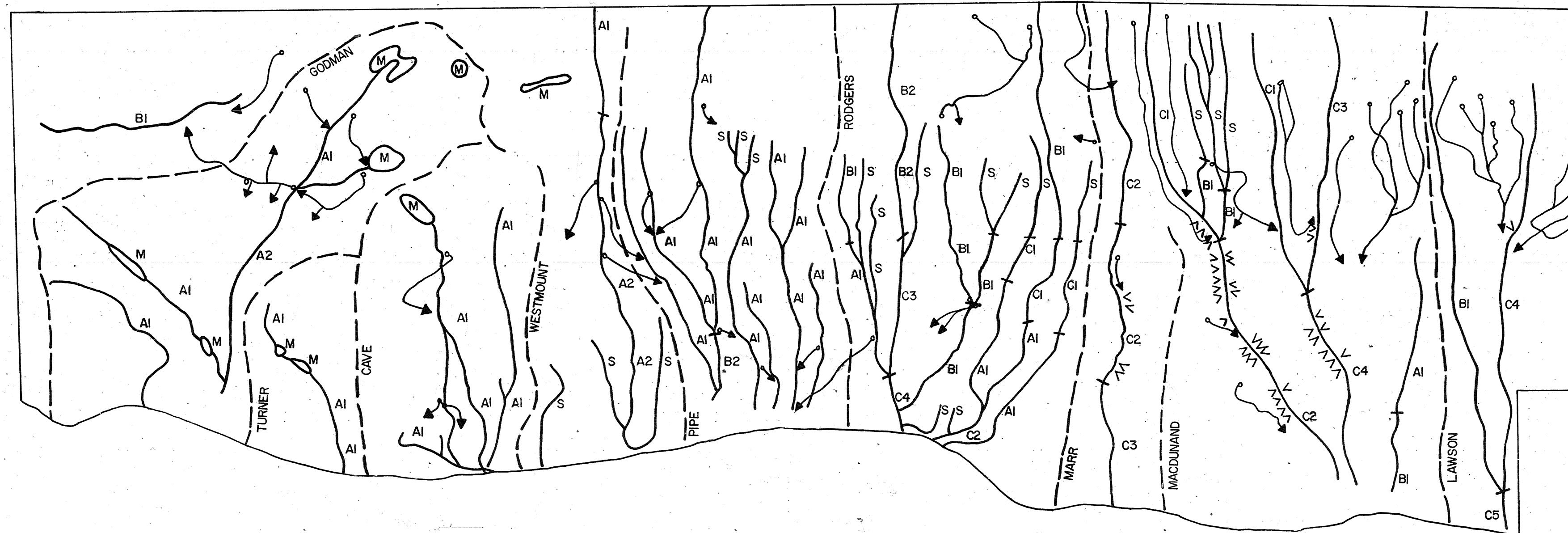
Symbol	Definition
1	- drainage area 0-100 A
2	- drainage area 100-200 A
3	- drainage area 200-300 A
4	- drainage area 300-400 A
5	- drainage area 400 A

C. Altered Drainage and Slumping

Symbol	Definition
→	- source channel and outlet of gullies
>	- slumping of ravine walls along channels

Symbol Example

A ₁	- a poorly confined channel with a drainage area less than 100 A
