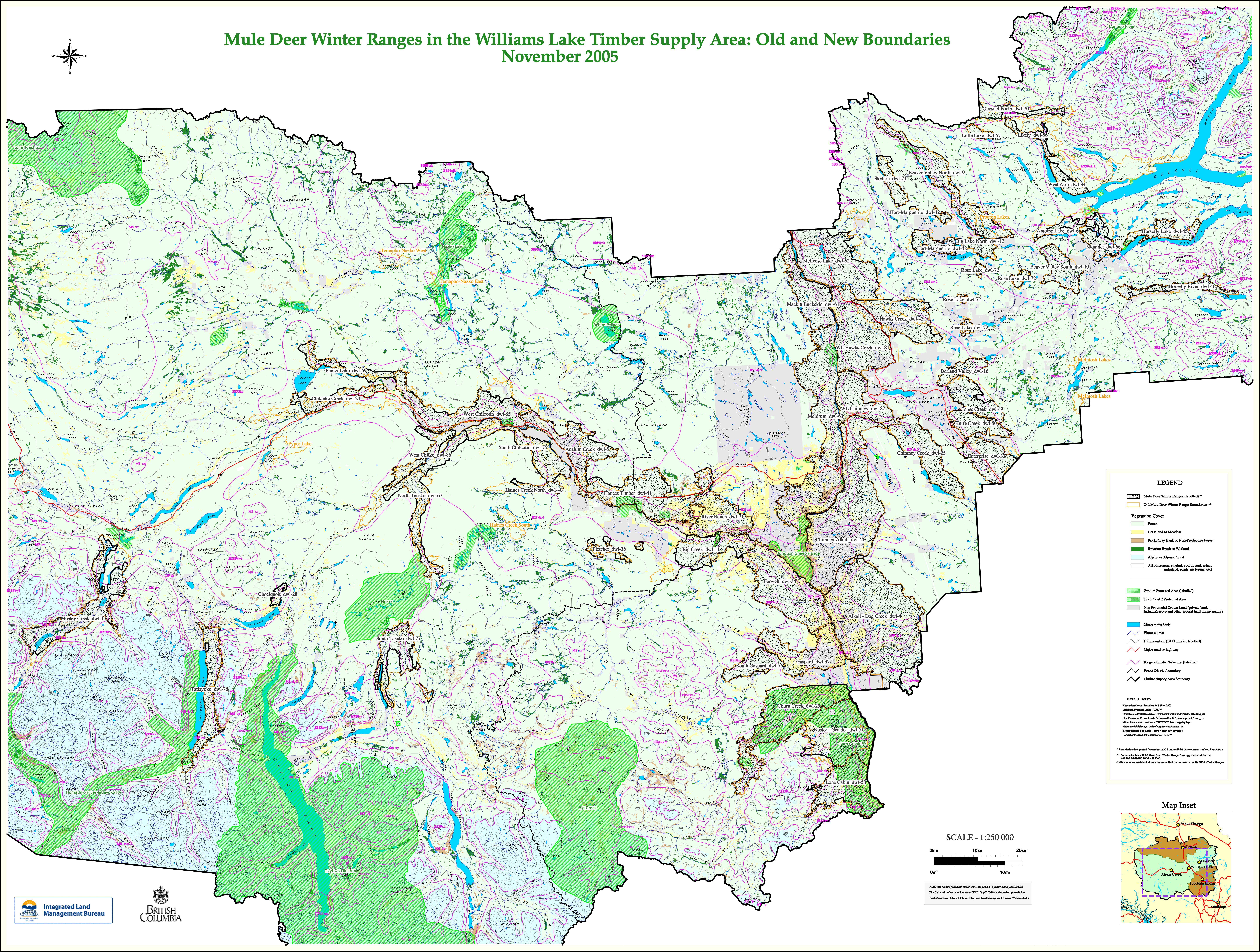
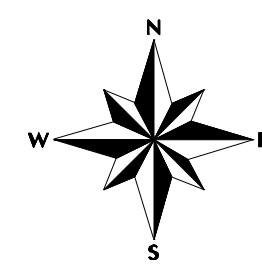


Mule Deer Winter Ranges in the Williams Lake Timber Supply Area: Old and New Boundaries November 2005
