Proposed Province-wide Bait Ban for Streams

The Ministry of Water, Land and Air Protection is presently considering a province-wide ban on the use of bait in streams. Lake fisheries are NOT affected by this proposal. Information on the rationale can be found on pages 2 and 19 of the present (2005-06) regulations synopsis (http://wlapwww.gov.bc.ca/fw/fish/pdf/provincial_regulations_2005.pdf). In general, this change would address several concerns, including:

- (a) Survival of released fish angling trends are toward more catch and release, and fish caught on bait are more prone to lethal hooking injuries;
- (b) High catch rates more fish can be caught on bait, resulting in reduced seasons and also increasing the overall number of potential severe hooking injuries among released fish;
- (c) *Transfer of disease* fish diseases can be transferred from one watershed to another by bait; and,
- (d) *Simplified regulations* this regulation would be harmonize the stream angling regulations across the province, hopefully resulting in simplification.

In the Kootenays, there are presently 34 regulations banning bait on streams. These water-specific regulations would no longer be required. However, we recognize that there are certain streams where bait fishing can still be offered, providing a traditional angling opportunity without unacceptable risk to the fish populations. Regional Fisheries staff will be developing a suggested list of exemptions to the bait ban, but your feedback is needed to help us produce this list. *Please submit your comments using the form attached to this information package (Word document also available – see Regional regulations web site for link).*
