

**ORDER - AMENDMENT FOR UNGULATE WINTER RANGE  
U-1-004, UNIT UWR004 AND UNIT UWR015**

This order is given under the authority of sections 9(1) and 12(1) of the *Government Actions Regulation* (B.C. Reg. 582/2004).

The Deputy Ministry of Forests, Lands and Natural Resource Operations, orders that:

- a. the boundary for Ungulate Winter Range U-1-004, Units UWR004 and UWR015 is amended as shown on the attached map "Amendment to Ungulate Winter Range U-1-004, Unit UWR004 and UWR015", and contained in the UWR spatial layer stored in the Geographic Warehouse (WHSE\_WILDLIFE\_MANAGEMENT.WCP\_UNGULATE\_WINTER\_RANGE\_SP). The centre point of the line on the map denoting the UWR is what establishes the boundary;
- b. the boundary replaces the boundary approved for Units UWR004 and UWR015 established on December 17, 2003, for Black-tailed Deer (*Odocoileus hemionus columbianus*) and Roosevelt Elk (*Cervus elaphus roosevelti*);
- c. the previous boundary of Ungulate Winter Range U-1-004, Unit UWR004 established on December 17, 2003, and contained in the UWR spatial layer stored in the Geographic Warehouse (WHSE\_WILDLIFE\_MANAGEMENT.WCP\_UNGULATE\_WINTER\_RANGE\_SP), is established as a specified area; and,
- d. all other objectives established for Ungulate Winter Range U-1-004 on December 17, 2003, continue to apply.

The Deputy Ministry of Forests, Lands and Natural Resource Operations, being satisfied that:


- i. the general wildlife measures (GWMs) described below are necessary to protect and conserve for Black-tailed Deer and Roosevelt Elk; and
- ii. GAR or another enactment does not otherwise provide for that protection or conservation;

orders that:

- a. the GWMs outlined in Schedule 1 are applied to the specified area.

**Schedule 1 – General Wildlife Measures Applicable to the Specified Area of U-1-004**  
**Unit UWR004**

1. The road CC104.004 is to be deactivated, upon completion of primary forest activities in cutblocks L037C3K7 and L037C3K8
2. Any primary forest activities (except ground-based tree planting) within the specified area should occur between April 1 and November 15, unless:
  - a. primary forest activities will not cause material adverse effects to Black-tailed Deer or Roosevelt Elk; and
  - b. the Ecosystem Biologist is notified of primary forest activities outside of these dates.,
3. Timber harvested for the creation of the road or right-of-way can be removed from the specified area.
