

ORDER

AMENDMENT FOR UNGULATE WINTER RANGE #U-1-005 UNIT 18

This order is given under the authority of Sections 9(2) and 12(1) of the *Government Actions Regulation* (B.C. Reg. 582/2004).

The Director of Resource Management of the West Coast Natural Resource Region, Ministry of Forests, Lands and Natural Resource Operations orders that:

- The boundary of Unit 18 in Ungulate Winter Range U-1-005 is amended, as shown on the attached map "Amendment to UWR U-1-005 Polygon Unit No. 18" and contained in the UWR spatial layer stored in the GeoBC Geographic Warehouse (WHSE_WILDLIFE_MANAGEMENT.WCP_UNGULATE_WINTER_RANGE_SP). The centre point of the line on the map denoting the UWR is what establishes the boundary.
- 2. The boundary replaces the boundary approved for Unit 18 on May 16, 2007, for Black-tailed Deer (*Odocoileus hemionus columbianus*) and Roosevelt Elk (*Cervus elaphus roosevelti*).
- 3. Where there is any discrepancy between the UWR boundaries as shown in the attached map and the UWR spatial layer stored in the GeoBC Geographic Warehouse, the boundaries as detailed in the UWR spatial file will take precedent.
- 4. The general wildlife measures established for Ungulate Winter Range U-1-005 on May 16, 2007, continue to apply.
