ORDER – AMENDMENT TO UNGULATE WINTER RANGE #U-2-005

This order is given under the authority of sections 9(2) and 12(1) of the *Government Actions Regulation* (B.C. Reg. 582/2004).

The Deputy Minister of Environment orders that:

1. the boundaries of unit J47-80-RE in ungulate winter range U-2-005 are amended as shown on the attached map “Amendment to U-2-005, Polygon Unit No. J47-80-RE”, and replaces the boundaries of unit J47-80-RE in ungulate winter range U-2-005 approved on February 28, 2005 for black-tailed deer (*Odocoileus hemionus*) and moose (*Alces alces*);
2. where there is any discrepancy between the ungulate winter range boundaries as shown in the attached maps and the GIS file *tuwra_bc*, the boundaries as detailed on the GIS file will take precedent. The centre point of the line on the map denoting the UWR is what establishes the boundary; and,
3. the general wildlife measures established for unit J47-80-RE in ungulate winter range U-2-005 on February 28, 2005 apply to the amended boundaries of unit J47-80-RE.
