ORDER – AMENDMENT TO UNGULATE WINTER RANGE #U-1-014

This order is given under the authority of sections 9(2) and 12(1) of the *Government Actions Regulation* (B.C. Reg. 582/2004).

The Deputy Minister of Environment orders that:

1. the boundaries of units Q07e and N04e in ungulate winter range U-1-014 are amended as shown on the attached maps “Amendment to UWR U-1-014, Polygon Unit No. Q07e” and “Amendment to UWR U-1-014, Polygon Unit No. N04e”, and replaces the boundaries of unit Q07e and N04e in ungulate winter range U-1-014 approved on December 14, 2004 for black-tailed deer (*Odocoileus hemionus columbianus*) and Roosevelt elk (*Cervus elaphus roosevelti*);
2. where there is any discrepancy between the ungulate winter range boundaries as shown in the attached maps and the GIS file *tuwra_bc*, the boundaries as detailed on the GIS file will take precedent. The centre point of the line on the map denoting the UWR is what establishes the boundary; and,
3. the general wildlife measures established for units Q07e and N04e in ungulate winter range U-1-014 on December 14, 2004 apply to the amended boundaries of units Q07e and N04e.
