



ORDER – Wildlife Habitat Area # 1-135 to 1-164

The following order applies to the areas shown in the maps set out in the attached Schedules A and takes effect on the ____ day of _____, 2004.


This order is given under the authority of sections 7(2) and 8(1) of the *Government Actions Regulation* (B.C. Reg. 17/04) and section 7(3) of the *Forest Planning and Practices Regulation* (B.C. Reg. 14/04).

The Deputy Minister of Water, Land and Air Protection orders that:

1. the wildlife habitat areas shown in the maps set out in the attached Schedules A 1-135 to 1-164) are established;
2. the wildlife habitat area in the attached Schedules A are established for Marbled Murrelet (*Brachyramphus marmoratus*); and
3. the general wildlife measures outlined in Schedule 1 are established for the wildlife habitat areas in the attached Schedules A:
4. pursuant to section 7(3) of the *Forest Planning and Practices Regulation* the person(s) required to prepare a forest stewardship plan are hereby exempted from the obligation to prepare results or strategies in relation to the objective set out in section 7(1) of the *Forest Planning and Practices Regulation* for Marbled Murrelet in the Campbell River Forest District for the amount of mature timber harvesting landbase and non-contributing landbase encompassed by the wildlife habitat areas shown in the maps set out in the attached Schedules A 1-135 to 1-164).

Schedule 1 – General Wildlife Measures

1. *Access* – Do not construct or widen roads unless the designated decision maker is satisfied there is no other practicable option and an exemption is approved.
2. *Harvesting and Silviculture* – Do not harvest timber except for salvage or traditional aboriginal purposes when the designated decision maker approves an exemption.
3. *Recreation* – do not develop recreational structures, trails, or facilities.
4. *Pesticides* – do not use pesticides unless an exemption is approved by the delegated decision maker.
