ORDER

WILDLIFE HABITAT AREAS

MINOR BOUNDARY AMENDMENT FOR WHA-1-107


This order is given under the authority of Sections 9(2) and 10(1) of the *Government Actions Regulation* (B.C. Reg. 582/2004).

1. The Regional Executive Director of the West Coast Region, Ministry of Forests, Lands and Natural Resource Operations orders that:
 - a. The boundary of Wildlife Habitat Area (WHA) 1-107 is amended as shown on “Amendment to WHA 1-107”, and is contained in the WHA spatial layer stored in the GeoBC Geographic Warehouse (WHSE_WILDLIFE_MANAGEMENT.WCP_WILDLIFE_HABITAT_AREA_POLY). The centre point of the line on the map denoting the WHA is what establishes the boundary;
 - b. This boundary replaces the boundary approved for WHA-1-107 on March 28, 2006 for Marbled Murrelet (*Brachyramphus marmoratus*);
 - c. Where there is any discrepancy between the WHA boundaries as shown in the attached map and the WHA spatial layer stored in the GeoBC Geographic Warehouse, the boundaries as detailed in the WHA spatial file will take precedent; and,
 - d. The general wildlife measures approved for WHA-1-107 on March 28, 2006 and the Exemption approved on April 7 2016 continue to apply.

ORDER – Amendment to Wildlife Habitat Area
1-107
Marbled Murrelet – North Island-Central Coast Forest District

This order is given under the authority of sections 9(2) and 10(1) of the *Government Actions Regulation* (B.C. Reg. 582/2004).

The Deputy Minister of Environment orders that:

1. the boundary of wildlife habitat area (WHA) 1-107 is amended as shown in the attached Schedule A “Amendment to WHA 1-107” and in the GIS file *twha_bc*. The aforementioned boundary replaces the boundary approved for WHA 1-107 on March 28, 2006 for Marbled Murrelet, (*Brachyramphus marmoratus*)
2. where there is a discrepancy between the WHA boundaries as shown in the attached Schedule A and the GIS file *twha_bc*, the boundaries as detailed in the GIS file will take precedent. The centre point of the line on the map denoting the WHA is what establishes the boundary; and
3. the general wildlife measures established for WHA 1-107 on March 28, 2006 apply to the amended boundary of 1-107, established by this order.
