



## ORDER

### WILDLIFE HABITAT AREAS

#### MINOR BOUNDARY AMENDMENT FOR WHA-1-200

This order is given under the authority of Sections 9(2) and 10(1) of the *Government Actions Regulation* (B.C. Reg. 582/2004).

1. The Director of Resource Management, Regional Operations Division-Coast Area, Ministry of Forests, Lands and Natural Resource Operations orders that:
  - a. The boundary of Wildlife Habitat Area (WHA) 1-200 is amended as shown on “Amendment to WHA 1-200”, and is contained in the WHA spatial layer stored in the GeoBC Geographic Warehouse (WHSE\_WILDLIFE\_MANAGEMENT.WCP\_WILDLIFE\_HABITAT\_AREA\_POLY). The centre point of the line on the map denoting the WHA is what establishes the boundary;
  - b. This boundary replaces the boundary approved for WHA-1-200 on July 24, 2006 for Marbled Murrelet (*Brachyramphus marmoratus*);
  - c. Where there is any discrepancy between the WHA boundaries as shown in the attached map and the WHA spatial layer stored in the GeoBC Geographic Warehouse, the boundaries as detailed in the WHA spatial file will take precedent; and,
  - d. The general wildlife measures approved for WHA-1-200 on July 24, 2006 continue to apply.
