



ORDER

WILDLIFE HABITAT AREAS

MINOR BOUNDARY AMENDMENT FOR WILDLIFE HABITAT AREAS 2-162 and 2-164

This order is given under the authority of Sections 9(2) and 10(1) of the *Government Actions Regulation* (B.C. Reg. 582/2004).

1. The Director, Resource Stewardship Operations, Land Use Planning and Cumulative Effects Division, Strategic Land Use, Coast Area – South Coast Region, Ministry of Water, Land and Resource Stewardship orders that:
 - a. The boundary of Wildlife Habitat Areas (WHAs) 2-162 and 2-164 are amended as shown on the attached maps “**Amendment to WHA 2-162**” and “**Amendment to WHA 2-164**” and are contained in the WHA spatial layer stored in the GeoBC Geographic Warehouse (WHSE_WILDLIFE_MANAGEMENT.WCP_WILDLIFE_HABITAT_AREA_POLY). The centre point of the line on the map denoting the WHA is what establishes the boundary;
 - b. This boundary replaces the boundaries approved for WHAs 2-162 and 2-164 on December 2, 2004 for Marbled Murrelet (*Brachyramphus marmoratus*);
 - c. Where there is any discrepancy between the WHA boundaries as shown in the attached maps and the WHA spatial layer stored in the GeoBC Geographic Warehouse, the boundaries as detailed in the WHA spatial file will take precedent; and,
 - d. The general wildlife measures approved for WHAs 2-162 and 2-164 on December 2, 2004 continue to apply.
