



ORDER
WILDLIFE HABITAT AREAS
MAJOR BOUNDARY AMENDMENT FOR WHA-1-264

This order is given under the authority of Sections 9(2) and 10(1) of the Government Actions Regulation (B.C. Reg. 582/2004).

1. The Regional Executive Director of the West Coast Natural Resource Region, Ministry of Forests, Lands, Natural Resource Operations and Rural Development orders that:
 - a. The boundary of Wildlife Habitat Area (WHA) 1-264 is amended as shown on “Amendment to WHA 1-264”, and is contained in the WHA spatial layer stored in the GeoBC Geographic Warehouse (WHSE_WILDLIFE_MANAGEMENT.WCP_WILDLIFE_HABITAT_AREA_POLY). This new boundary encompasses the former area of WHA-1-265, removing 1-265 as a separate WHA. The centre point of the line on the map denoting the WHA is what establishes the boundary;
 - b. This boundary replaces the boundaries approved for WHA-1-264 and WHA-1-265 on January 12, 2010 for red-legged frog (*Rana aurora*);
 - c. Where there is any discrepancy between the WHA boundaries as shown in the attached map and the WHA spatial layer stored in the GeoBC Geographic Warehouse, the boundaries as detailed in the WHA spatial file will take precedent; and,
 - d. The general wildlife measures approved in the Order for WHAs 1-221, 1-264 to 1-267 and 1-271 on January 12, 2010 and the Exemption approved on April 13, 2012 continue to apply.


