**ORDER – WILDLIFE HABITAT AREAS**  
**MINOR BOUNDARY AMENDMENT FOR WHAs-5-274 and 5-275**

This order is given under the authority of Sections 9(2) and 10(1) of the *Government Actions Regulation* (B.C. Reg. 582/2004).

1. The Director of Resource Management, West Coast Region, Ministry of Forests, Lands and Natural Resource Operations orders that:
  - a. The boundaries of Wildlife Habitat Areas (WHAs) 5-274 and 5-275 are amended as shown on the attached map “**Wildlife Habitat Area Amendment 5-274 and 5-275**”, and is contained in the WHA spatial layer stored in the GeoBC Geographic Warehouse (WHSE\_WILDLIFE\_MANAGEMENT.WCP\_WILDLIFE\_HABITAT\_AREA\_POLY). The centre point of the line on the map denoting the WHA is what establishes the boundary;
  - b. These boundaries replace the boundaries approved for WHA 5-274 on February 7 2006, and 5-275 on July 8 2013 for Grizzly Bear (*Ursus arctos horribilis*);
  - c. Where there is any discrepancy between the WHA boundaries as shown in the attached map and the WHA spatial layer stored in the GeoBC Geographic Warehouse, the boundaries as detailed in the WHA spatial file will take precedent; and,
  - d. The general wildlife measures approved for WHA 5-274 and 5-275 on February 7, 2006 continue to apply.



#### MINOR BOUNDARY AMENDMENT FOR WHA-5-275
