The provisions of the British Columbia Water Act having been complied with and being satisfied that no person's rights will be affected, I hereby amend clauses (d) and (e) of Final Water Licence No. 6332, Wolf Creek, to read as follows:

- (d) The purpose for which the water is to be used is Industrial and domestic.
  - (e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted is 1,010,000 gallons a day.

Industrial - 1,000,000 gallons a day.

Domestic - 10,000 gallons a day.

I also amend the said Final Water Licence No. 6332 by deleting clause (k).


