

ORDER

Section 37 Water Sustainability Act

IN THE MATTER OF Final Water Licence 7308 authorizing the diversion and storage of 98,678.4 cubic metres per annum for Stream Storage: Non-Power purpose for Final Water Licence 7306.

HAVING DETERMINED THAT no other water supply is reasonable available I hereby authorize the use of water authorized under this licence to be used on land, other than the land to which the licence is appurtenant with the terms and conditions set out below:

- 1) The point of diversion is located as shown on the plan attached to Final Water Licence 7308.
- 2) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted to fill the reservoir is 49,340 cubic metres (40 acres feet) per annum.
- 3) The period of the year during which the water may be diverted into storage is October 1st to June 1st.
- 4) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Lot 1 Section 8 Township 19 Range 17 West of the 6th Meridian Kamloops Division Yale District Plan EPP46305.
- 5) The authorized works are diversion structure, ditch and dam which shall be located approximately as shown on the plan attached to Final Water Licence 7308.
- 6) This order is issued under the *Water Sustainability Act* (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.
- 7) No compensation has been requested or made.
- 8) The licence holder must be notified prior to the withdrawal of water under this order.
- 9) The quantity and duration of water withdrawal must be reported to the licensee within 30 days of use.

This extension of rights expires July 26, 2016.
