FINAL WATER LICENCE

(Storage)

WHEREAS **GREATER VANCOUVER WATER DISTRICT** whose
address is **Vancouver, B.C.**

is the owner of the land, mine, or undertaking to which **Final Licence 8454**
appurtenant, and is the applicant for this licence; and **Conditional Licence No. 9236** ~~was~~ **were** made
and particularly that the works for the storage of the water under the said licence **Water Licence 1675**
and

Whereas satisfactory proof has been duly filed, and it has been shown to the satisfaction of the
Comptroller that the terms of the said ~~conditional~~ licence have been complied with satisfactorily, and
particularly that the works for the storage of the water under the said licence have been completed;

Whereas a licence or record has been previously issued or made in respect of the said land, mine,
or undertaking, being Licence No. **8689** (hereinafter called the "diversion licence"), authorizing
the beneficial use of **84 cubic feet per second** of water per annum
(Quantity.)

for **Waterworks** purpose, which quantity of
water, the water to be stored under the licence hereby issued, is intended to supply in whole or in
part; and it appearing that the water authorized to be stored under the conditional licence first above
mentioned has been put to a beneficial use:

Now, therefore, in pursuance of the "Water Act, 1914" this final licence is issued, granting the
licensee thereunder the right to store water under the following terms and conditions:--

- (a.) The source of the supply is **Seymour creek,**
and the reservoirs are Seymour creek, Loch Lomond and Burwell
a tributary of lake.
- (b.) The point or points of diversion from the stream or streams, and the points where the
stored water is to be placed in and taken from any natural watercourse or any dry gulch
or draw is shown in the exhibit marked "A." hereto attached, which is incorporated here-
with and made a part hereof, the original of which exhibit is on file in the office of the
Comptroller of Water Rights, Parliament Buildings, Victoria.
- (c.) The date from which this licence and the right to store water thereunder shall take
precedence is **19th April 1928.**
- (d.) The purpose for which the stored water is to be used is that set out in the diversion
licence or record.
- (e.) The maximum quantity of water which may be stored under this licence, estimated for the
time being at **Seymour creek 1350**
Loch Lomond 5500
Burwell lake 11200 acre-feet per annum, is such
quantity as, together with the quantity of natural-flow water used under the diversion
licence or record will be necessary to secure to the licensee the quantity to which he is
entitled under the said diversion licence or record
- (f.) The period of the year during which the water may be stored is **the whole year.**

and the licensee shall so store the same subject to the approval of the Engineer of the
Water District.

(g.) The land, mine, or undertaking on which or in respect of which the water may be used is as set out in the said diversion licence or record.

(h.) The works constructed for the storage of the water consist of

Seymour creek, Concrete dam, Plan 2326L (L-91-RI),
Loch Lomond, Tunnel and pipes, " 2875G (L-89-RR),
Burwell lake, Rock-fill crib dam, tunnel and pipes, Plan 2876H
(C-10-R).

(i.) Before any change is made in the said works which would be a material deviation from the plans as approved or the works as accepted by the Comptroller, plans of such proposed change must be filed with the Comptroller and approved by him.

(j.) This licence shall be appurtenant to the waterworks undertaking of the Greater Vancouver Water District.

(k.) The terms and conditions of this licence shall replace those of the ~~conditional~~ licence ~~first above~~ mentioned.

(l.) This licence is issued in substitution of the following licences, all of which are hereby surrendered and cancelled:



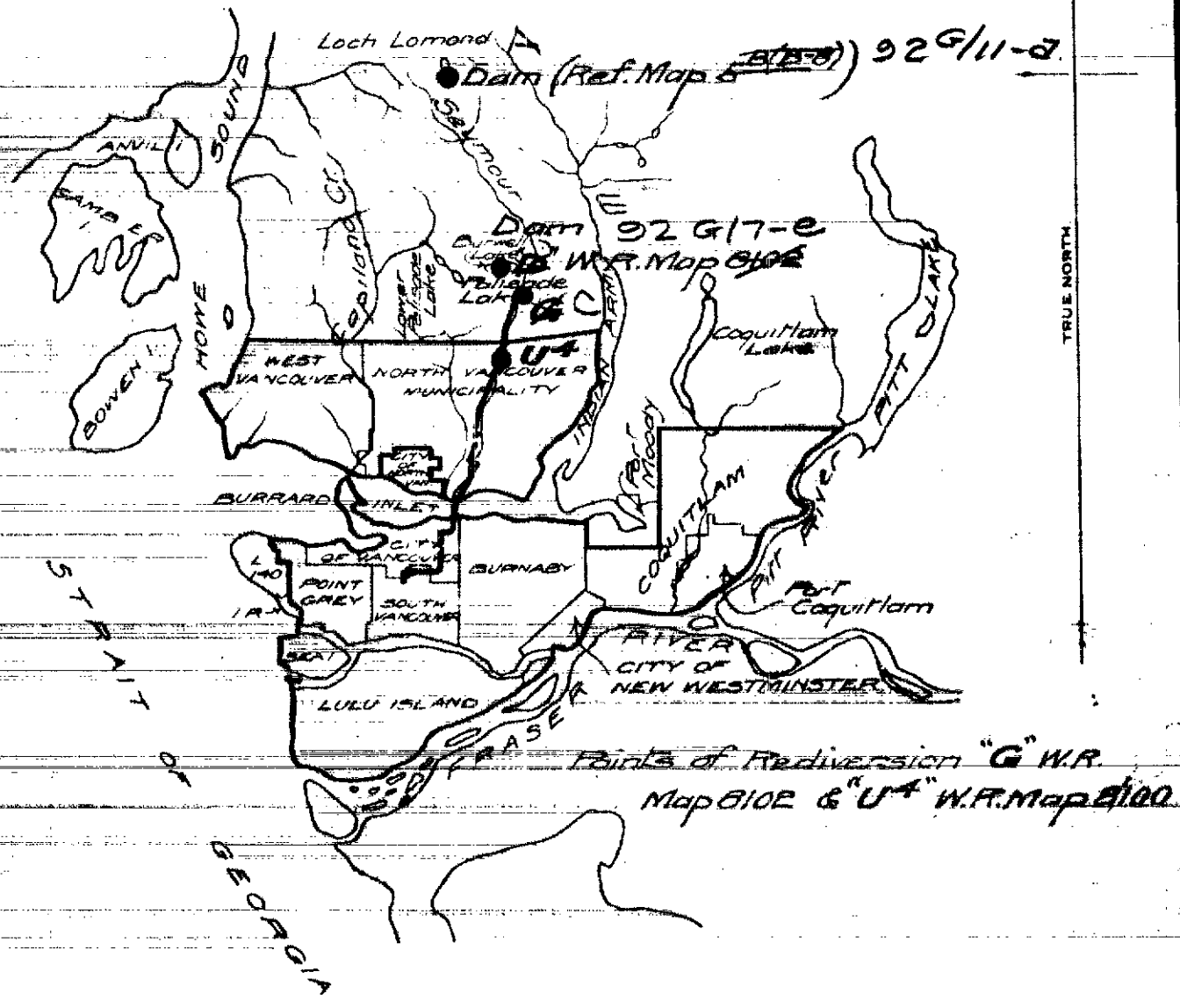
