THE ATTORNEY GENERAL OF THE PROVINCE OF
BRITISH COLUMBIA, of Victoria, B. C., is

hereby authorized to use water as follows:—

(a.) The source of the water-supply is **Le Jeune (Trout) Lake flowing into Meadow Creek.**

~~(b.) The point of is located as shown on the attached plan.~~

(c.) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is **18th July, 1932.**

(d.) The purpose for which the water is to be used is **Industrial (Fish Culture).**

(e.) The maximum quantity of water which may be used is **the natural flow available.**

~~and such additional quantity as the Engineer may from time to time determine should be allowed for losses.~~
(f.) The period of the year during which the water may be used is **the whole year.**

~~(g.) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is~~
The location of the spawning beds in which the water may be used is in the portions of Le Jeune (Trout) Lake, situated on the S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 36 and the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 26, Township 17, Range 19, West of 8th Meridian.

(h.) The works for the use of the water are **dams and fish traps.**

(i.) This licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water Licence No. **11558.**

In the matter of Final Water Licence 11247, which authorizes the use of water from Le Jeune Lake for industrial (fish culture) purpose.

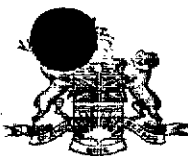

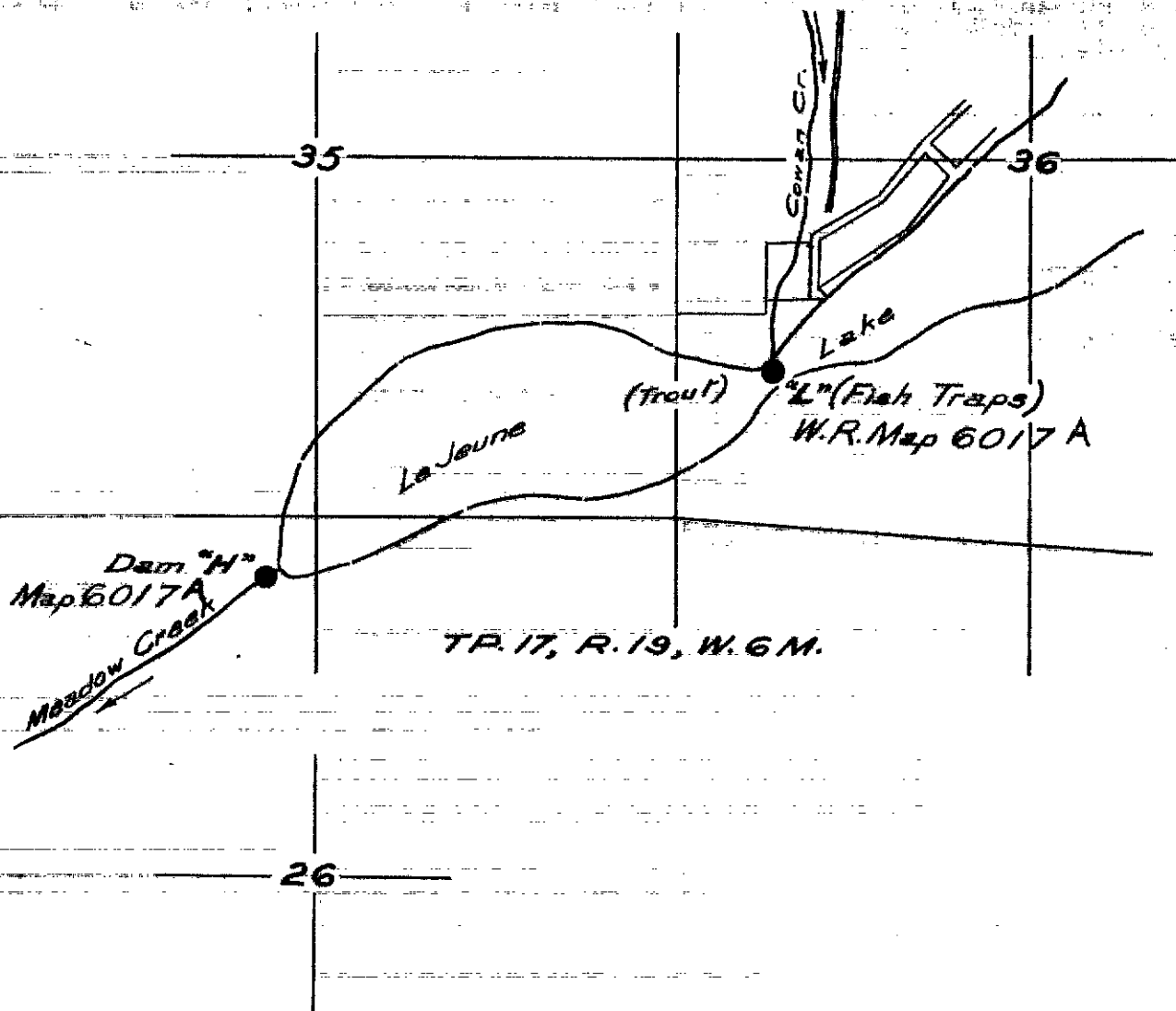
