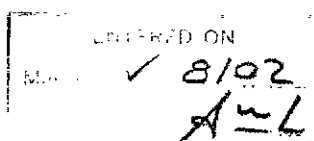

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

Greater Vancouver Water District, of 2294 West 10th Ave., Vancouver 9, B. C.,

is/are hereby authorized to store water as follows:—

- (a) The source (s) of the water-supply is/are Seymour Creek.
- (b) The point (s) of storage is/are located as shown on the attached plan.
- (c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is 7th August, 1958.
- (d) The purpose for which the water is to be used is as set out in Final Water Licence No. 8689 and Conditional Water Licence No. 16297.
- (e) The maximum quantity of water which may be stored is 19,150 acre feet per annum,
and such additional quantity
as the Engineer may from time to time determine should be allowed for losses.
- (f) The period of the year during which the water may be stored is the whole year.
- (g) ~~The land upon which the water is to be used and to which~~ This licence is appurtenant to the Waterworks Undertaking of the Greater Vancouver Water District.
- (h) The works authorized to be constructed are dam with spillway crest elevation at 790 feet,
and they shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- (i) The construction of the said works shall be commenced on or before the 30th day
of April, 1959, and shall be completed and the water beneficially
used on or before the 31st day of December, 1963.
- (j) The Comptroller of Water Rights shall issue an order on or before October 1st 1959, setting forth the quantity and time of water releases through the dam authorized in clause (h) hereof, for the purpose of maintaining a flow of water in the Seymour Creek for fish propagation. Such water releases may be altered or discontinued by a subsequent order or orders of the Comptroller of Water Rights if the water so released is needed by the licensee for Waterworks purpose.

NEW WESTMINSTER LAND DISTRICT

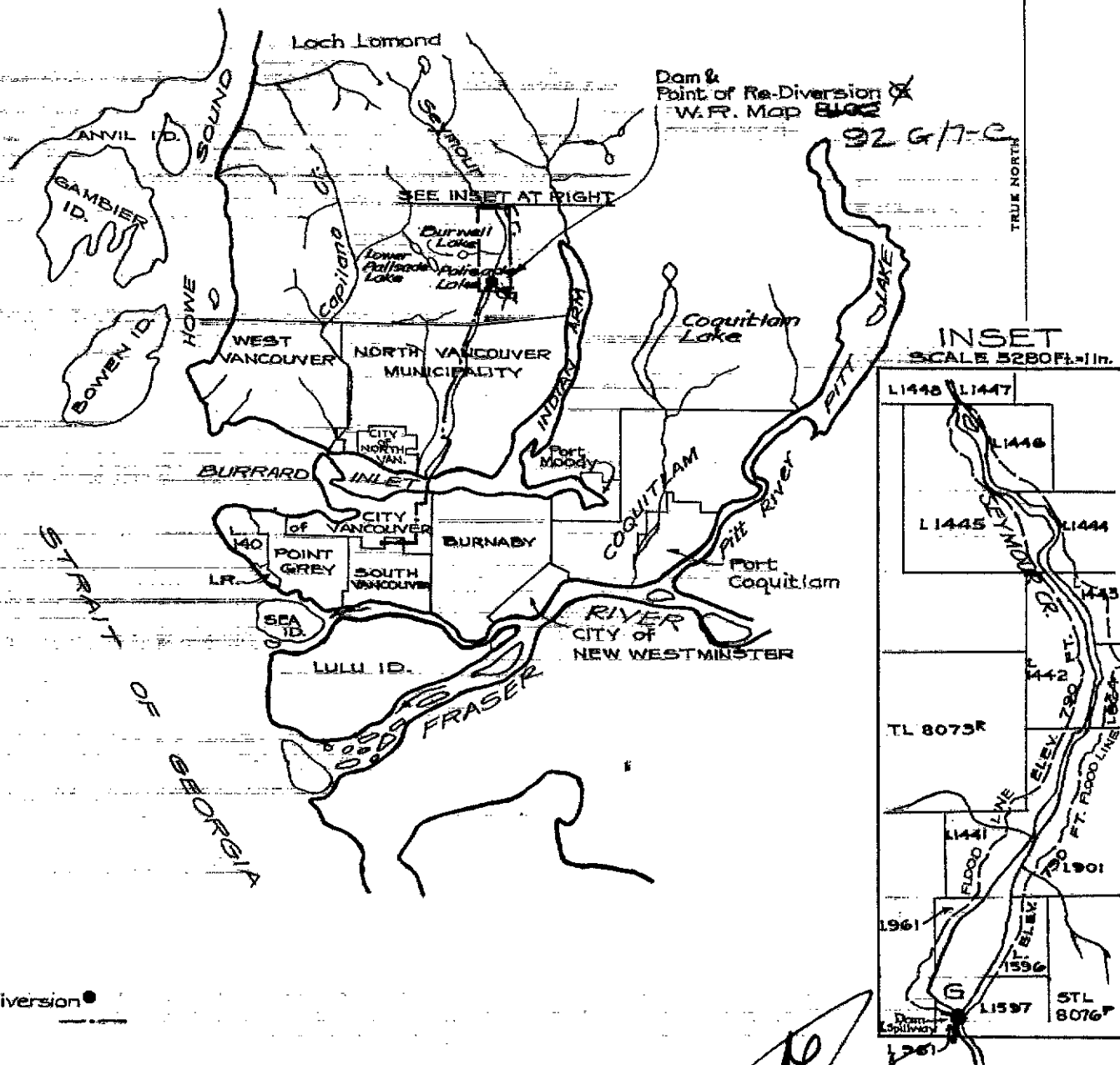



IN THE MATTER of Clause (j) of Conditional Water Licence
No. 24510, Seymour Creek, I hereby direct:

- (1) Until such time as the average waterworks use from the Seymour system exceeds 58,000,000 gallons per day for a 12 months period, the minimum flow (made up of Cougar Creek, leakage and controlled releases) immediately below the new Seymour Falls dam shall not be less than 48 cubic feet per second.
- (2) After the Waterworks use from the Seymour system exceeds 58,000,000 gallons per day for a 12 months period, water releases at the dam may be restricted to provide minimum flows immediately below the dam as shown on the Greater Vancouver Water District drawing WG-395, registered under No. 4258^F in the Water Rights Branch.
- (3) If because of unusual weather or other conditions different from those experienced to date, the depletion of storage becomes greater than the worst condition shown on the drawing referred to in (2) above, and an application from the Greater Vancouver Water District for a reduction in water releases is made, the Comptroller of Water Rights in consultation with the Department of Fisheries (Canada) may further reduce the quantity of water to be released through the dam.


