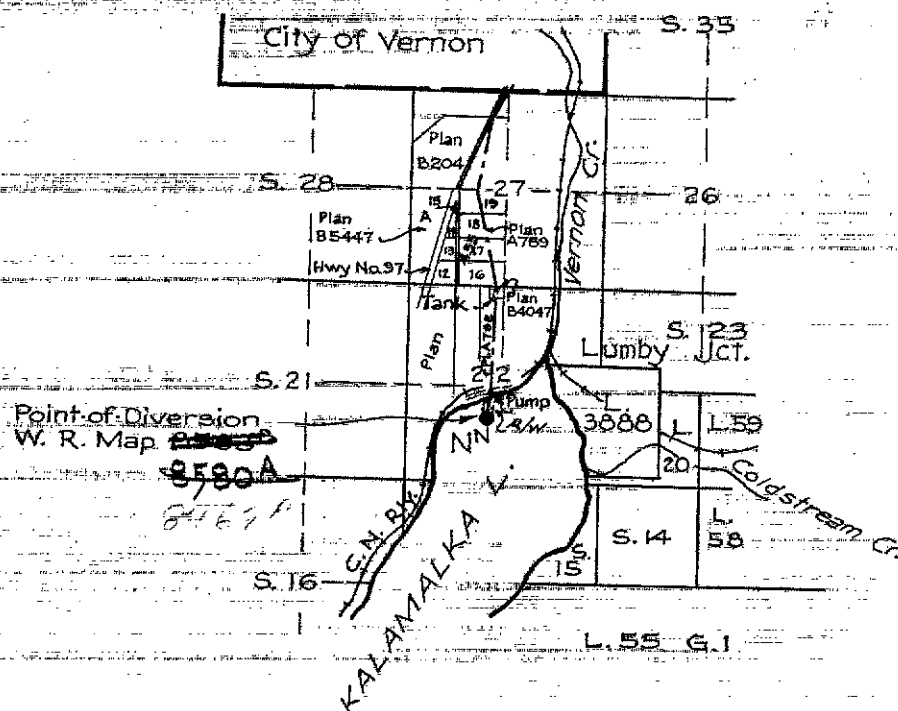

In the matter of Conditional Water Licence 25666, which authorizes the diversion of water from Kalamalka Lake for waterworks purpose;

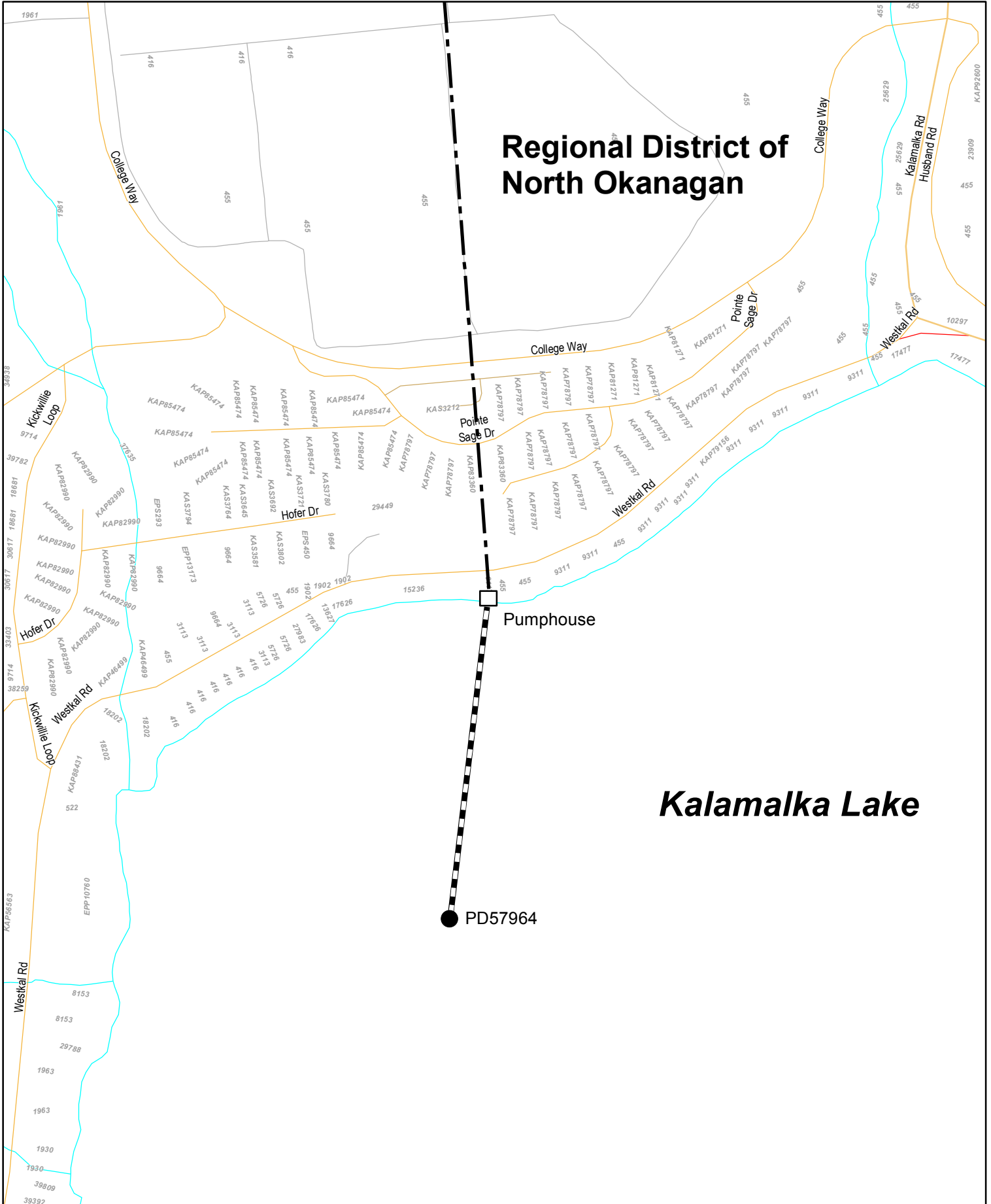
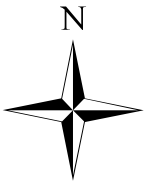

- h) The authorized works are screened intake, pipe and pump which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached amended plan.
