CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

Lower Nicola Waterworks District of P.O. Box 18, Lower Nicola, B.C.

is/are hereby authorized to **divert and use** water as follows:—

- (a) The source(s) of the water-supply is/are Guichon Creek.
- (b) The point(s) of **diversion**

is/are located as shown on the attached plan.

- (c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is 13th April, 1906.
- (d) The purpose for which the water is to be used is waterworks.
- (e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted is 95,000 gallons a day,

and such additional quantity as the Engineer may from time to time determine should be allowed for losses.

- (f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is 1st April to 30th September.
- (g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is to lands within the boundaries of Lower Nicola Waterworks District.
- (h) The works authorized to be constructed are **diversion structure**, pump, pipe, tank and distribution system,

which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.

- (i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water shall be beneficially used on or before the 31st day of December, 1974.
- (j) This licence is issued in substitution of Final Water Licence 8272, under Sections 15 and 16 of the Water Act.


