CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

Clyde H. Coats of Box 1, Gabriola Island, B. C.

is/are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:—

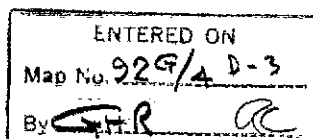
- (a) The source(s) of the water-supply is/are Hoggan Lake.
- (b) The point(s) of diversion is/are located as shown on the attached plan.
- (c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is 9th January, 1974.
- (d) The purpose for which the water is to be used is industrial (water delivery).
- (e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted is 20,000 gallons a day,
and such additional quantity
as the Engineer may from time to time determine should be allowed for losses.
- (f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is the whole year.
- (g) ~~The land upon which the water is to be used and in which~~ this licence is appurtenant ~~to~~ to the water hauling project of the licensee, Gabriola Island, Nanaimo District.
- (h) The works authorized to be constructed are pump and pipe,

which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- (i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water shall be beneficially used on or before the 31st day of December, 1975.
- (j) This licence may be cancelled at any time on one years notice in writing by the Comptroller of Water Rights.

ORDER

WATER ACT 1996, RS Chap 483

SECTION 18

File No. 0322338

IN THE MATTER of Conditional Water Licence 43118 which authorizes the diversion and use of 20, 000 gallons a day of water from Hogan Lake for the water hauling project of the licensee on Gabriola Island, Nanaimo District..

Having received from the licensee, an abandonment of a portion of the rights held under the above licence, and being satisfied that no person's rights will be injuriously affected, I hereby amend Clause (e) of the said licence to read as follows:

(e) "The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted is 5,000 gallons a day."

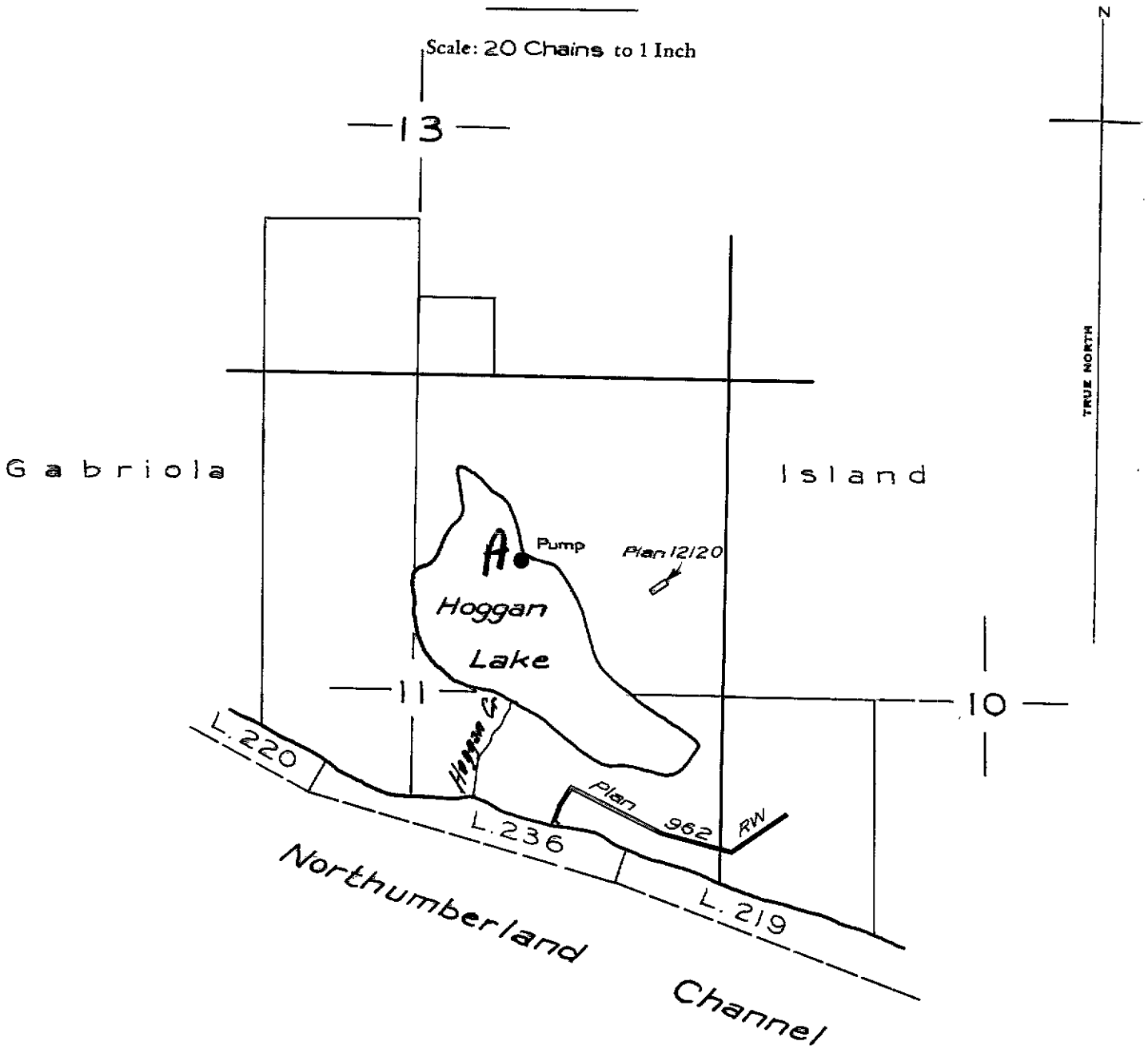
