CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

Armside Mining Ltd. (N.P.L.) of 15th Floor, 1030 West Georgia Street,  
Vancouver, B.C.

is/are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:—

- (a) The source(s) of the water-supply is/are Loss Creek.
- (b) The point(s) of diversion is/are located as shown on the attached plan.
- (c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is 20th September, 1973.
- (d) The purpose for which the water is to be used is Mining (Placer) and Industrial (campsite).
- (e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for mining (Placer) purpose is 3,000 gallons a day and for industrial (campsite) purpose is 1,000 gallons a day, and such additional quantity as the Engineer may from time to time determine should be allowed for losses.
- (f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is the whole year.
- (g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Placer Mining Leases 257 and 258, Renfrew District.

(h) The works authorized to be constructed are pump, pipe and plant,

which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.

(i) The construction of the said works shall be commenced on or before the 30th day of November, 1975, and shall be completed and the water beneficially used on or before the 31st day of December, 1978.
